Assembly passes Senate Bill 10 **Authored by Rep. Robert Wittke and Sen. Dale Kooyenga**

Madison, WI – Rep. Robert Wittke of Wind Point released the following statement regarding the passage of Senate Bill 10 by the Assembly.

“I am honored that my Assembly colleagues chose to join me in removing workforce barriers with the passage of Senate Bill 10. As Wisconsin looks to build our workforce, legislation of this nature is critical. By recognizing the academic excellence of our higher education institutions and technical colleges, we take an important step to moving students into the field of accounting sooner and with proper training.”

Senate Bill 10, and its companion Assembly Bill 15, seeks to modify the educational qualifications for certified public accountants, extending the transferability of credits for students seeking certification.
