Wittke's Racine Public Interest Bill Signed into Law

Madison – Representative Robert Wittke (R-Racine) authored [Assembly Bill 502](#) along with fellow Racine area legislators. This bill would provide flexible notification for the District Attorney's office with regard to Children in Need of Protective Services (CHiPS) or Termination of Parental Rights (TPR) case proceedings allowing for an efficient process for families.

“This bill was requested by Racine County and I'm pleased to have worked on finishing the law making process on behalf of the county” said Wittke. “The bill would give counties the ability to choose the most effective and efficient way to handle CHiPS/TPR proceedings, and would provide for more timely completion of these cases and cost savings to the taxpayers of the county.”

The bill was signed into law early this afternoon, and is now 2019 Wisconsin Act 134.
