Madison – Rep. Bob Wittke (R-Racine) issued the following statement following Governor Evers State of the State Address January 22, 2019 before a joint session of the Wisconsin State Legislature.

“It was a great experience to be in attendance at my very first State of the State Address. I believe the state of our state is strong. When I chose to run for office I wanted to contribute in a positive way to policies that benefit the economy and our Wisconsin way of life.
